Here at Martin High School, we recognise the importance that learning to play a musical instrument can have on a young adult. Music is one of life's joys and a great gift. It can enrich lives and open doors to a fabulous range of careers. Giving your child instrumental lessons can have a huge impact, not only in terms of them being able to play a musical instrument, but also in their general well-being, for example:

- Academic Development Concentration

- Improved motor skills & brain function

We therefore encourage as many pupils as possible to start and learn a musical instrument.

To match how other schools in the Lionheart Academy Trust manage their instrumental tuition, our provision here at Martin High School will be provided by a fabulous team of private teachers, all of which are monitored and attend training sessions with the Leicester-Shire Music Service. This will mean direct communication with your instrument teacher and more affordable lesson fees which in turn will make learning a musical instrument more financially viable for more pupils to take up an instrument. Tuition is generally provided throughout the school day and when planning the instrumental lesson timetables, we try very hard to avoid withdrawing pupils from the core subjects, meaning some lessons may operate on a rota system.

If you are interested in booking lessons for your child, please complete the contact sheet attached and return to Mrs Shaw at Martin High School. Mrs Shaw will contact your chosen instrument teacher to let them know numbers of pupils interested and will also pass on your email address for the instrument teacher to send you all the information you need to book your lessons.

Can we take this opportunity to inform you that all contracts are between yourselves (the parent/carer) and the instrumental teacher, meaning that once lessons have begun, all questions regarding payment and issues regarding your instrument lessons will only be dealt with by the teacher you have signed a contract with, and not Martin High School.
