Economic- Use the money to stabilise the country.

Benefits of cities/countries hosting major sporting events

- Increased tourism. \succ
- Commercial benefits- Sponsors & \succ investments.
- Increased participation in sport. \succ
- Moral of the country is raised-National \succ pride.
- \succ Investment in improving/ developing transport system.
- ➤ Sports facilities- improved/ new ones built.
- Social facilities built can be used by \succ people who live in the area where the events have been held.



Drawbacks of cities/countries hosting major sporting events

- Bidding to host can be expensive and you may not win.
- \succ The event can cost more than the money raised.
- ► Facilities can end up not being used after the event.
- ➤ Can have a negative effect on the country if the event is not run properly.
- ▶ Hosting the event helps promote one area of sport- others may suffer as consequence.
